Overview

This is **not a rally**. Advocacy Day is focused on respectful, scheduled conversations with legislators.

No prior advocacy experience is required.

Training & Preparation

MN CAI will provide training and speaking points in advance. Training will prepare participants on key legislative issues, how to effectively communicate with legislators, and how to share their experience clearly and professionally.

- **Afternoon** – Continued legislator meetings
- **4:00 PM** – Wrap-up and final debrief
